



IADFS 2026 abstract submission

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The abstract word limit is max. 250 words per abstract.
- Deadline for submission- 21st July 2026.
- Product brand names are not allowed in the abstract title or abstract text. Use generic names only. A brand name can be inserted as a reference at the bottom of the abstract page.
- Abstracts submitted will be designated for either oral, poster or video technique (minimum 2 minutes and maximum 3 minutes) presentations by the reviewing committee.
- If a publication has been presented before the congress the authors should state this in the end of the abstract (in the text). The committee will then take this into account when reviewing the abstracts.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

A. General Conditions

- Abstracts can be stated for oral presentations, posters or video techniques.
- Deadline for submission- 21st July 2026
- For video techniques abstract submissions, when provisionally accepted, the 2-3-minute, high quality video should be submitted within the notified deadline for a final approval and selection.
- Accepted submissions will be notified on 27th July 2026
- Accepted abstracts will be published in the abstract book for the conference.
- Withdrawal of abstracts can only be accepted if notified in writing and subsequently confirmed by the panel.

B. Presenting Author and Registration

- The presenting author must confirm on or before 30th July 2026 and register as an active participant at the conference within 14 days after acceptance of an abstract.



- The conference team reserves the right to exclude any abstract that is not followed by a participant registration at the latest 14 days after notification of acceptance.

C. Contents of Your Abstract

- The abstract word limit is max. 250 words per abstract.
- The title should be as brief as possible but long enough to clearly indicate the nature of the study.
- No identifying features such as names of authors, hospitals, institutions of places may be listed within the body of the abstract.
- All abbreviations must be defined in first use.
- The abstract must include the following:
 - **Aim:** State the purpose of the study
 - **Methods:** Describe your subjects and observations
 - **Results:** Results in a logical sequence in text, table and illustrations
 - **Conclusions:** Brief factual conclusions

D. Video techniques Abstract Submissions

- The abstract word limit is max. 250 words per abstract.
- A clear and true description of the technique and the steps and the rationale for each step.
- Product brand names are not allowed in the abstract title or abstract text. Use generic names only. A brand name can be inserted as a reference at the bottom of the abstract page.

E. Reviewing

- The IADFS scientific committee will review the abstract
- It is the responsibility of all investigators that all studies are performed with respect to national legislation, international legislation and ethical guidelines both with regards to humans and animals. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject any submitted abstract that is believed to violate these principles.
- Please check that your email address (submitter and presenting author) is correct as it will be used for contacting you after the review process.
